

HANDS-ON FUN WITH COLORS

Share the joy of exploring colors and include a tactile reinforcement of learning by making play dough, and including your child in the making of new colors.

Play Dough Recipe

1 cup flour
1 cup warm water
1/4 cup salt
1 teaspoon oil
2 teaspoons cream of tartar
Food coloring

Mix all ingredients in a sauce pan, adding food coloring last. Cook and stir over low/medium heat until play dough is completely formed and no longer sticky. Allow to cool slightly before storing in an air tight container or zip lock bag.

No-Cook Play Dough

2 cups flour
1 cup water
Kool-Aid or Jell-O for color

Combine ingredients and slowly add water, a little at a time. Mix together well. This no cook recipe is a bit more grainy than the traditional, but requires no cooking.

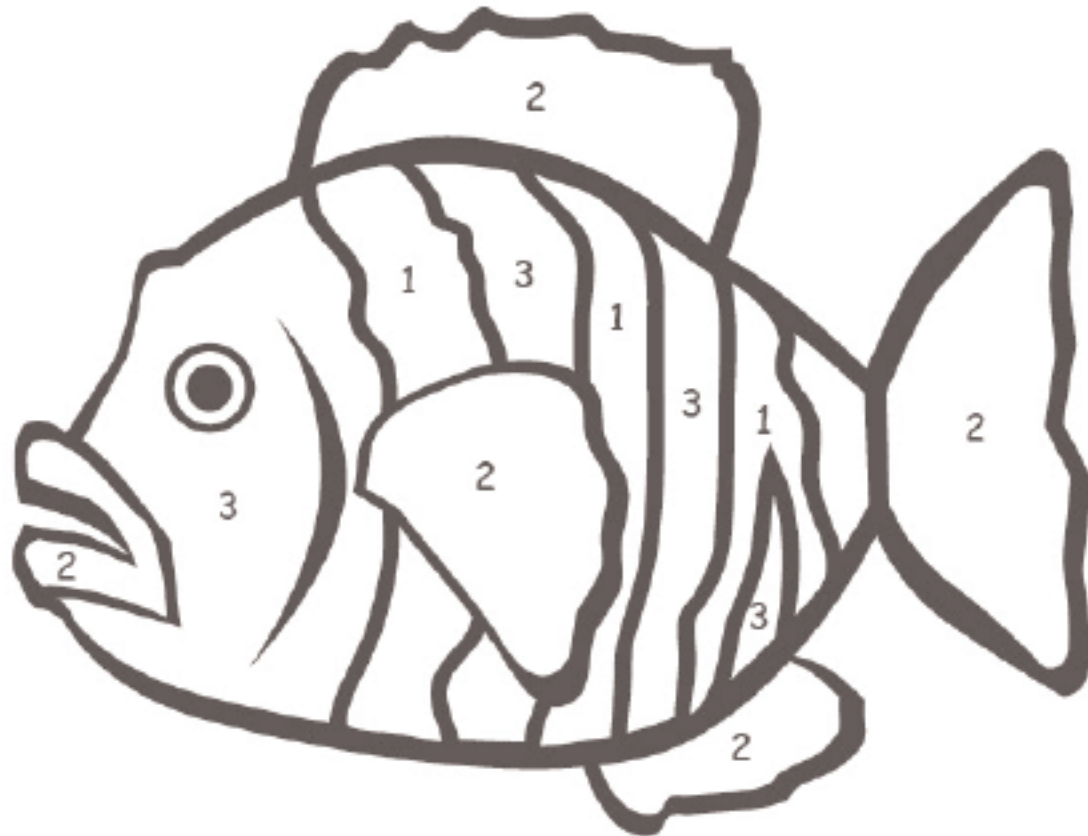
Practice saying each of the colors as your child plays with the play dough.

You can also make all the colors of the rainbow using your three new colors, Red, Blue and Yellow:

Red and Yellow make Orange
Blue and Red make Purple.
Yellow and Blue make Green.
